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### **Anthem Choice Supp Plan**

In the event you should not receive your new Anthem ID cards by December 31, 2016, please contact Anthem Blue Cross at (800) 967-3015 to request new cards.

If you need to see your physician and haven't received your ID card you can:

- 1) Print a Temporary ID Card: Log on to [www.anthem.com/CA](http://www.anthem.com/CA) and login (or click *register now* if you are not yet registered on the Anthem site). You can register by using the policyholder's SSN.
- 2) View Your Card on the Mobile App: You can view your ID card on your mobile phone by using Anthem's free mobile app.
  - a. Download the free app – just search for *Anthem Blue Cross* at the app/play store on your phone.
  - b. Access the app, log on or click *register now* if you aren't already registered. You can register by using the policyholder's SSN.
- 3) Visit Your Doctor: You can visit your doctor without your ID card and provide the policyholder's SSN and provide what plan you are enrolled in (e.g., Anthem Choice PPO). The office can then call Anthem's Customer Service to verify your eligibility and benefits:

### **Express Scripts Pharmacy**

A Welcome Kit with your new member ID card will be mailed to you if your enrollment is approved by CMS.

To process prescriptions without an ID card, you can provide your pharmacist the following plan information:

- Effective Date: January 1, 2017
- The Pharmacy Benefits Manager: Express Scripts (ESI) Medicare
- Issuer Number: 9151014609
- Bin Number: 610014
- Rx Group Number: EIAEGWP
- Rx PCN: MEDDPRIME
- Policyholders's SSN
- Policyholder's Date of Birth
